## Read 1 Peter 5:7

**“Give all your worries and cares to God, for he cares about you.”**

Take a few moments and think of all the worries and concerns in your life. For each situation or person you are worried about, tie a prayer knot in your yarn.

Jesus also said, "Can all your worries add a single moment to your life?...So don't worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will bring its own worries.
